In fact, the challenges of 2020 has made us more resolute to establish KTP into a profitable and sustainable business entity.

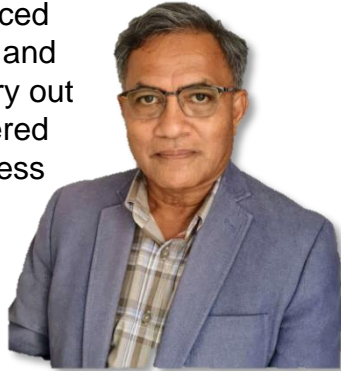
And for that, on behalf of the board, we sincerely thank each and every member of KTP for your generosity, support and contribution.

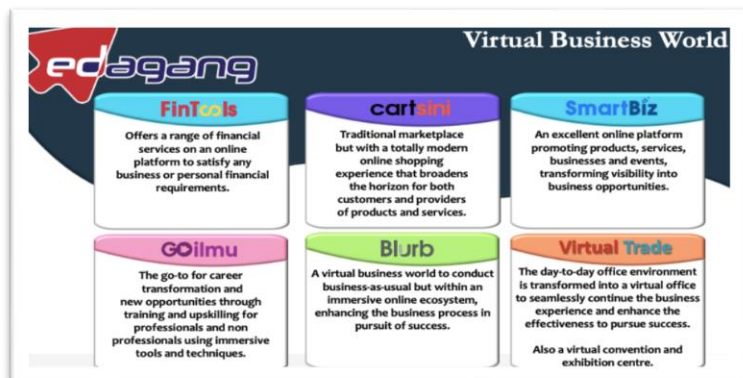

Ferry Services Malaysia - Indonesia

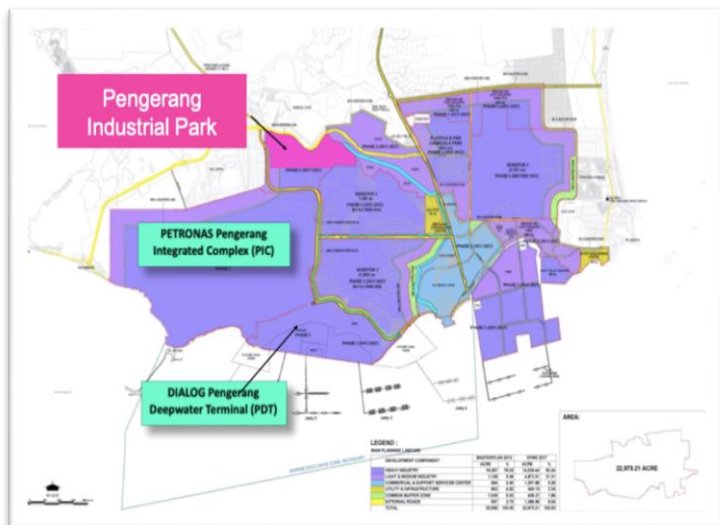

MoU with MOGSC

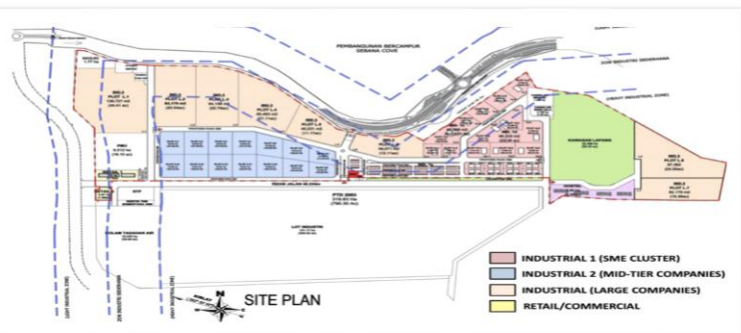


KTP has signed an MOU with MOGSC to collaborate on joint projects and other initiatives for the benefit of the members of both organizations.
